## San Bruno AYSO College Scholarship

### 2011-12 Application

San Bruno AYSO awards up to three \$500 or \$1000 scholarships each year to deserving AYSO U-19 players who have demonstrated a commitment to volunteer service, community support and academics. Interested students who meet the criteria must submit a completed application by **April 13, 2012**. A committee consisting of AYSO Region 249 Board Members will review all submitted applications and make a recommendation to the Regional Board for their approval.

The minimum criteria required are as follows:

1. Must be a 2012 graduating high school senior.
2. Must have been a registered player during the regular AYSO Fall seasons for a minimum of three years. Seasons played need not be consecutive, but the student must have played the Fall 2011 season in San Bruno Region 249.
3. Must have supported AYSO through volunteer activities.
4. Must have a cumulative High School GPA of 3.0 or better verified by official transcript.
