It is easy to become new AYSO coach. After submitting a volunteer application and receiving approval. You are ready to begin your training, which is provided free of charge.

It's a golden opportunity to spend quality time with your child. The rewards you receive from helping kids have fun and contributing to their individual skills and teamwork will last a lifetime. The experience of choosing your own team, deciding when and where your practices will be held is an added bonus to becoming a coach.

AYSO's U-6, U-8, U-10, and U12 courses are all considered "stand alone" courses, meaning that you may take any one of them without having taken any prior courses. The U-12 course becomes the prerequisite for taking the Intermediate course for U-14, which is the prerequisite for taking the Advanced course needed for U-16 & U-19.

Course commitment times are as follows

U-6 Coach - 2 hours

U-8 Coach – 2 hours

U-10 Coach - 3 hours

U-12 Coach - 5 hours

U-14 Coach (Intermediate) – 15 hours

U-16 & U-19 Coach (Advanced) - 18 hours

Last year San Bruno AYSO had over 85 teams participating in our program. Without dedicated volunteers signing up to return as coaches or the addition of new coaches coming on board, our program can't continue to provide a fun and safe experience for our children. We look forward to seeing you at soccer registration and hope you decide to become a volunteer in San Bruno.

WHAT IS EXTRA: AYSO EXTRA™ is designed for players who have the interest, skills, abili-

who have the interest, skills, abilities and desire to enhance their soccer experience and individual growth at a more challenging levelall the while retaining the spirit of the game and membership in AYSO. The EXTRA program embraces the Six Philosophies of AYSO.

WHY: To answer needs expressed by YOU, the parents and our players. You told us the main reason players were leaving AYSO was to find higher levels of play and competition with an improved learned skill level. The goal of EXTRA is to provide more competitive play The AYSO Way!

WHEN: If selected for the EXTRA Team your cost is \$60. Season runs from early August until mid November - with games

played on Sundays beginning right after Labor Day. Please know that you may end up on a team based in a different city within our Area; which could possibly be Millbrae, Pacifica or San Bruno.

EXTRA Concurrent ~ Players are rostered on an EXTRA team and a standard primary program team -- at the same time -- and participate fully with both teams. Players are eligible for All Star, tournament, National Games, travel and other secondary program teams.

Regular Season: September 15— November 17 Wouldn't it be nice if there was something that everyone could agree on. Well, there is one point that everyone in the AYSO Soccer universe can agree on: We all want our youth soccer matches to be played in a Safe, Fun, Fair, environment. Making that happen is what being an AYSO referee is all about.

Like a judge keeping the courtroom fair, or a playground monitor keeping the playground safe, the referee makes the game fun by ensuring fairness and safety.

"Safe, Fun, Fair" doesn't just apply to our young players - it applies to the AYSO family including grownups as well.

WH0: Must be at least 11 years old

Here's a plus for youths: The volunteer hours you complete with AYSO can be used to fulfill volunteer hours required by some communities and schools.

HOW: Becoming a referee might seem intimidating, but AYSO Region 249 makes it easy. The AYSO National Referee Program (NRP) is the best referee training available.

The course eases you into the role of referee through a step-by-step approach. You take an online course at your own pace then attend the companion field course which ends with a test to check for learning. Once you get a few games under your belt we have more in depth classes to help you improve your skills.

WHEN: After completing the online referee course let Martha Moran – Regional Referee Administrator - referee@SANBRUNOAYSO.ORG - know you are ready for the companion field course. It will be held on Sundays Aug 26, Sep 9, Sep 16 from 9 AM to 12:30 PM. You only need to attend one of the days. Additional classes will be scheduled as demand shows.

We'll also hold an orientation and refresher get together Sunday Aug 12 from 11AM to 1PM at Crestmoor field where you can find out more about being a referee or just get up to speed if it has been a while since you refereed. Volunteering

AYSO is an all volunteer organization. One way that AYSO protects players and volunteers is by requiring all volunteers to fill out a volunteer application annually and to be approved as a volunteer by both the local region and the national Safe Haven department.

If you're thinking of volunteering this year in any capacity, such as a coach, referee or team parent, we ask you to fill out an application as soon as possible so that you can be registered, trained and ready to go when the season starts.

To fill out an application, go to www.easyo.org and follow the instructions. You will then need to print three copies of your form, sign them, and bring all of them to one of the AYSO

registration events. If this is your first time volunteering in AYSO, you will also need to bring a picture ID with you.

We are having a special registration event just for volunteers on **April 18, from 6:30 to 8:30** at the San Bruno Veterans Memorial Recreation Center. By registering on this day, you can avoid the crowds and long lines that are common at other registration times.
