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Greetings Soccer Players and Families,

As we gear up for the Fall 2013 season, there are five registration days starting with a special registration date for Volunteers and their children the evening of April 17 with open registration running through the first weekend in June. We expect over 1,000 players ranging in ages 4 through 18 on over 100 teams playing soccer every Saturday through mid-November at Crestmoor and Parkside Fields. Within our program we also offer a VIP Program for our players with special needs. We look forward to offering the highest quality soccer program for your children during the course of the year. San Bruno AYSO (Region) is part of American Youth Soccer Organization, (AYSO) a national organization of youth soccer leagues of over 725,000 youth soccer players. AYSO has six core philosophies which help set the tone for our program for safe, fair and fun soccer. The six philosophies form the foundation for all that we do within our region – Everyone Plays, Balanced Teams, Open Registration, Positive Coaching, Good Sportsmanship and Player Development.

Start your Fall Season by with joining us at one or more of the soccer camps we offer. Summerkicks is an informal soccer clinic for U6 – U12 on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5:30 – 7:30 p.m. for the first three weeks in June at Crestmoor Field. We also offer four formal soccer camps at Crestmoor Field from Challenger Sports and UK Soccer Camps – June 24 – 28 - Challenger Sports
July 22 – 26 – UK Soccer Camps
July 29 - Aug 2 – Challenger Sports
Brazilian Style
August 12 – 16 – UK Soccer Camps.

Sportsmanship

One of our six core values is good sportsmanship. We strive to create a positive environment based on mutual respect, rather than a win-at-all-costs attitude, and our program is designed to instill good sportsmanship in every facet of AYSO.

It is very important that our coaches, referees, parents and volunteers demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times regardless of the outcome of the game. Young impressionable kids will notice how the adults around them are acting. If you're screaming and yelling at the referee, players, coaches, then the players will feel it is "okay" to do the same thing. Developing good sportsmanship is such a valuable skill that these kids will carry with them as they get older. It all starts with the parents, and it will be reinforced by their coaches and other AYSO volunteers. The goal of a soccer game is always to win BUT every game will only have one winner so it is very important to be a good sport no matter which team your child is on.

Coaches Corner

It's hard to believe but AYSO fall season is just around the corner already. San Bruno is always looking for caring volunteers to become AYSO coaches. Our veteran coaches have been giving their time and talents to ensure that the players of region 249 have a safe, fun, fair soccer experience. Most of the coaches have their own children in the program but because being a coach is so enjoyable and rewarding many of them continue coaching long after their own children have grown out of the program.

To become a new AYSO coach, all you need is to submit a volunteer application and receive approval. You are ready to begin your training, which is provided free of charge. It's a golden opportunity to spend quality time with your child coaching him/her how to play the game of soccer. The rewards you receive from helping kids have fun and contributing to their individual skills and teamwork will last a lifetime.

AYSO's U6, U8, U10, and U12 courses are all considered "stand alone" courses, meaning that you may take any one of them without having taken any prior courses. The U12 course becomes the prerequisite for taking the Intermediate course for U14, which is the prerequisite for taking the Advanced course needed for U16 & U19.

Course commitment times are as follows:

- U6 Coach –2 hours
- U8 Coach–2 hours
- U10 Coach–3 hours
- U12 Coach–5 hours
- U14 Coach (Intermediate)-15 hours
- U16 & U19 Coach (Advanced)–18 hours

Without dedicated volunteers signing up to return as coaches and the addition of new coaches coming on board, our program can't continue to provide a fun and safe experience for our children. We look forward to seeing you at soccer registration and hope you decide to become a volunteer in San Bruno.

Wouldn’t it be nice if there was something that everyone could agree on? Well, there is one point that everyone in the AYSO Soccer universe can agree on: we all want our youth soccer matches to be played in a Safe, Fair, Fun environment. Making that happen is what being an AYSO referee is all about. Like a judge keeping the courtroom fair, or a playground monitor keeping the playground safe, the referee makes the game fun by ensuring fairness and safety. **“Safe, Fair, Fun”** doesn’t just apply to our young players - it applies to the AYSO family including grownups as well. Referees must be at least 11 years old. Here’s a plus for youths: the volunteer hours you complete with AYSO can be used to fulfill community service volunteer hours required by some communities and schools.

Becoming a referee might seem intimidating, but AYSO Region 249 makes it easy. It is the best referee training available. The course eases you into the role of referee through a step-by-step approach. You take an online course at your own pace then attend the companion field course which ends with a test to check for learning. Once you get a few games under your belt, we have more in depth classes to help you improve your skills.

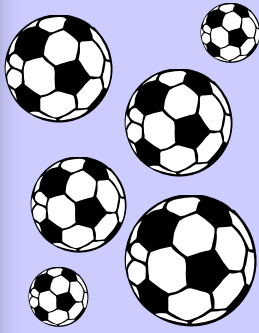

Important Requirements for Fall 2013

This year pre-printed Player and Volunteer Registration forms will no longer be available at registration events. You will need to pre-register your child(ren) and yourself online at www.eayso.org, then print and bring two (2) copies of the online forms to registration along with your payment.

We are using E-Signature starting with this registration. With E-Signature, Player Registration Forms and Volunteer Registration forms no longer require a "wet-ink" signature. In eAYSO.org, when prompted, check the box next to "I agree to use electronic signature". You must type your legal name when prompted for signature.

NOTE: We will have limited computer access at each registration event, but we recommend you complete the pre-registration process before coming to a registration event to save time and avoid long wait time.

- * Bring child's birth certificate (NEW players to San Bruno AYSO only)
- * For players who will be 10 and older as of August 1: bring a current photo (1" x 1 1/2") for use on Player ID cards (print full name of player on back of photo)
- * Bring your payment: check, cash, Visa or MasterCard

To help protect our players and volunteers, **all** AYSO volunteers are required to fill out a volunteer application each year and to be approved by our local region and the national Safe Haven department. This year, **all** volunteer applications will be completed online and will use e-signature.

We are having a special registration event just for volunteers on Wednesday, **April 17, from 6:30 to 8:30** at the San Bruno Veterans Memorial Recreation Center. Vol-

unteers and their families can register on this day and avoid the crowds and long lines that are common at other registration times. If this is your first time volunteering with our region you will also need to show photo identification, such as a driver's license.
